



Booth University College Sessional Instructor

The MBA Program of Booth University College invites applications for multiple **Sessional Instructor** positions in Business Administration (with a variety of specializations in Marketing, Accounting, Data Analyses & Research Methods, CSR, Leadership). The successful candidates will design and teach courses across the Master of Business Administration program. Preference will be given to applicants with demonstrated experience in graduate-level Business programs.

Core Responsibilities

Sessional faculty members are expected to prepare a syllabus, including course description, learning outcomes, course outline and assessment strategies using the Booth University College Syllabus Template. Sample syllabi will be provided to the successful candidates. Upon approval of the syllabus by the School Director and the Academic Office, detailed lesson plans are prepared in advance of course offering and posted to Populi (LMS), together with all relevant materials, including handouts, assigned reading, assignments and assessment rubrics.

Specifically, a Sessional Instructor is responsible to:

- Engage with students to provide academic support, clarify course material, and foster a responsive learning environment
- Deliver instruction in in-person, virtual and hybrid formats, combining instruction and technology through teaching methods, practices and tools and strong teaching strategies
- Collaborate effectively with program administration through clear communication, departmental meetings, and submission of report and documentation
- Develop and grade course exams and assignments to ensure alignment with learning objectives, academic standards and institutional policies while utilizing the SIS system

Qualifications:

All applicants must possess a PhD/DBA or hold equivalent teaching experience at the graduate level. Candidates with work in progress in doctoral studies will be considered if there is evidence of extensive teaching experience. (Candidates with a combination of CPA and MBA will be considered for accounting courses with a minimum of five years of executive work experience.) Satisfactory Criminal Record Check certificate must be provided. The successful candidate must have an active Christian faith and a commitment to the integration of faith and learning in a Christian university-level setting.

To Apply

Application materials should include:

- curriculum vitae,
- statement of teaching philosophy,
- statement on how your faith commitment would contribute to both teaching and scholarship at Booth UC,
- names and contact information for three references and
- evidence of effective teaching (provide samples of course syllabi, teaching outlines and other materials, if available).
