Business Source Premier lets you search for articles and essays on various aspects of business. This guide will give you a quick overview of the search page, the results list and options for how to save, request, and cite these sources for your research.

Database Name:

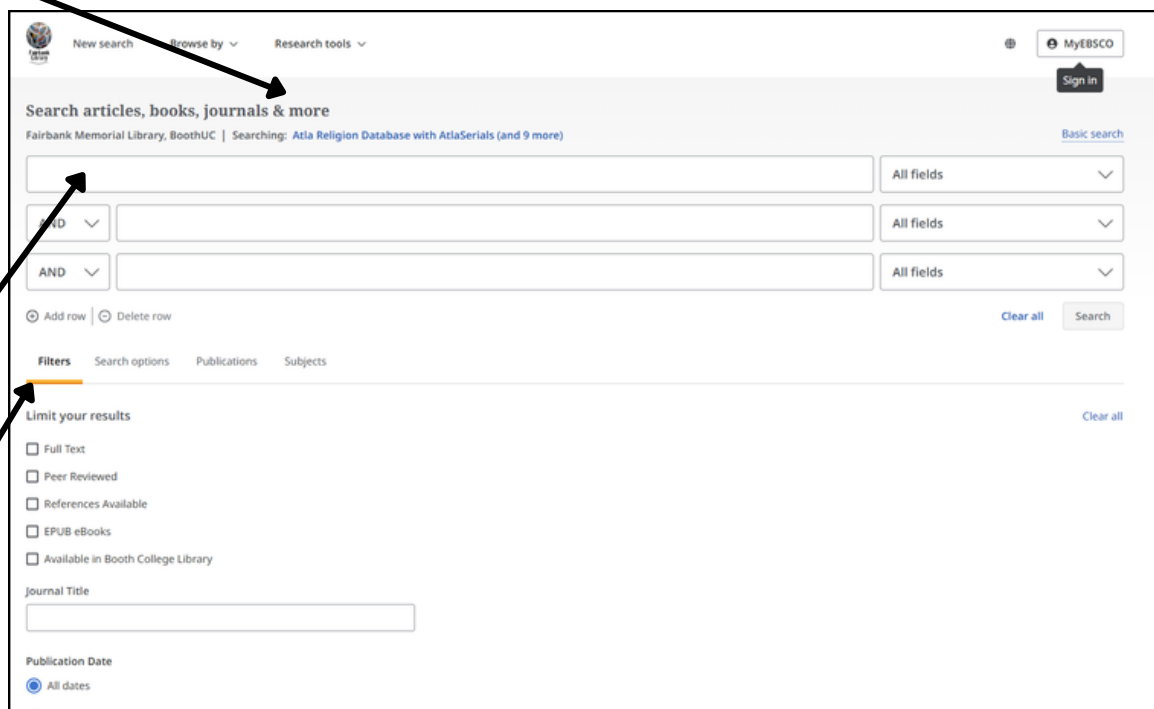
Click on Databases to search more than one at a time. This may increase the number of results you get.

Search:

Type in keywords or a phrase about your topic..

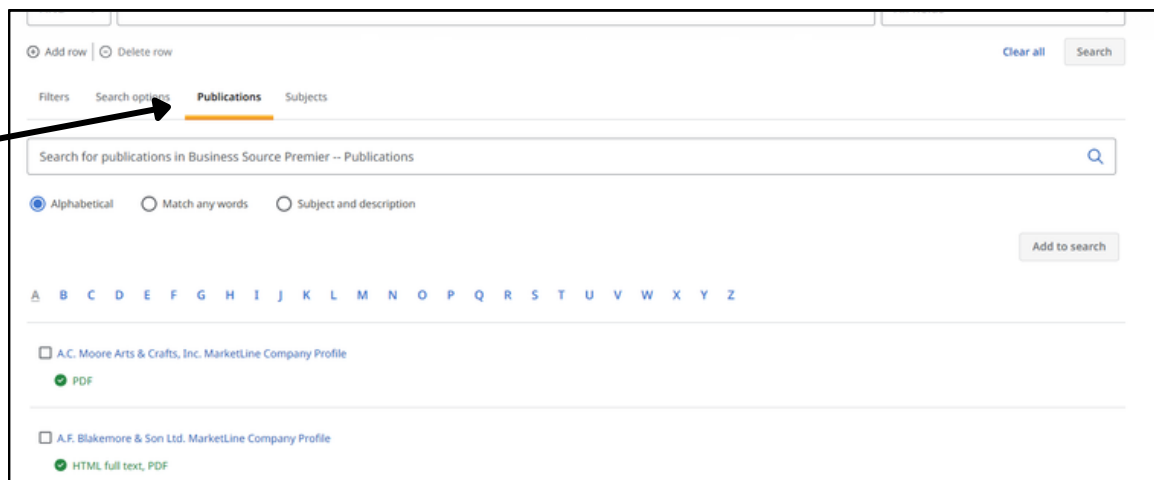
Filter:

Click on the Filters tab to narrow your results to peer reviewed sources, date, or other limiters.



Company Profiles:

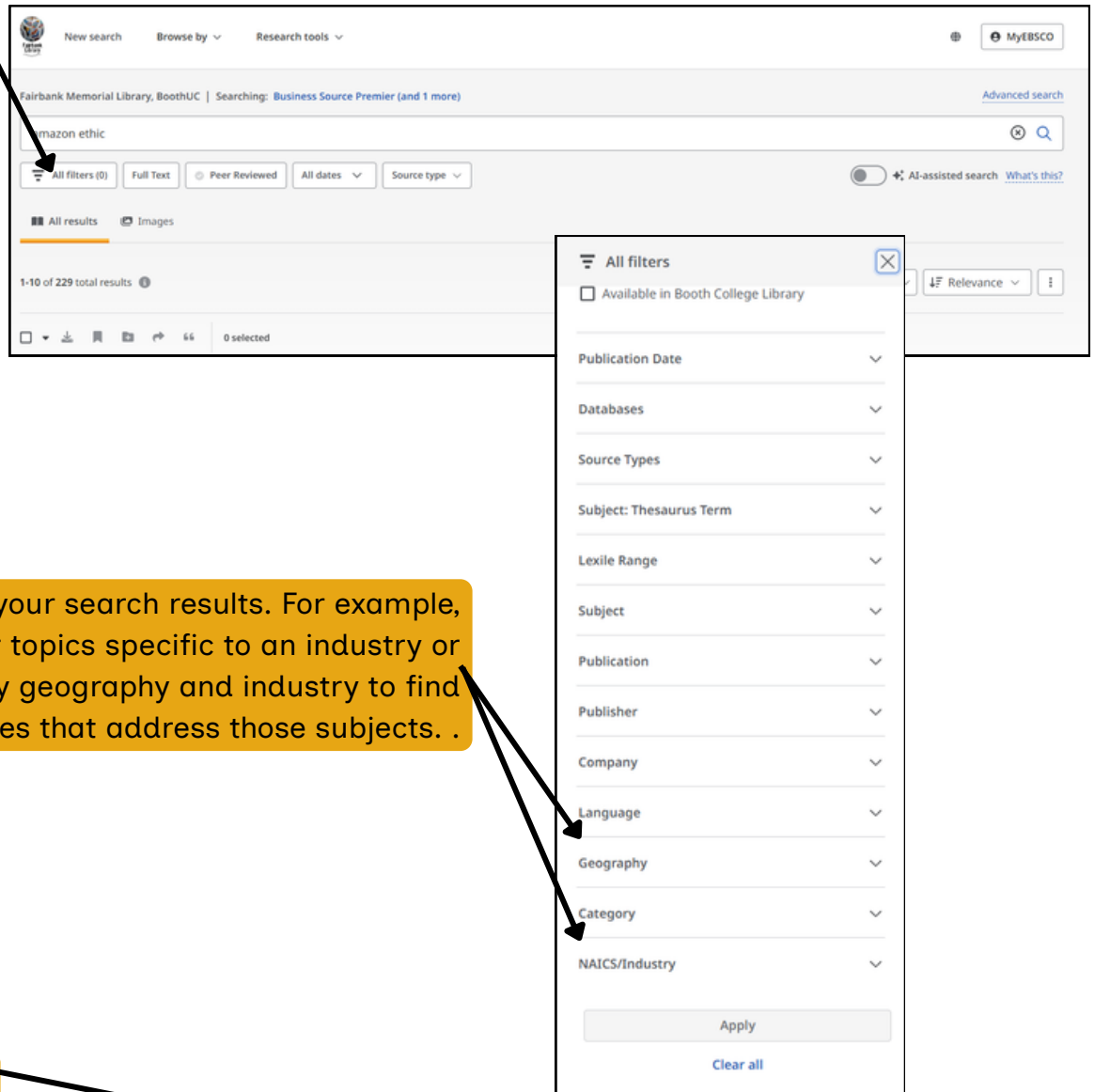
Click Publications to search company profiles..



Search Results

Filter:

Click All filters to narrow your results to peer reviewed sources, date, or other limiters, like subject.



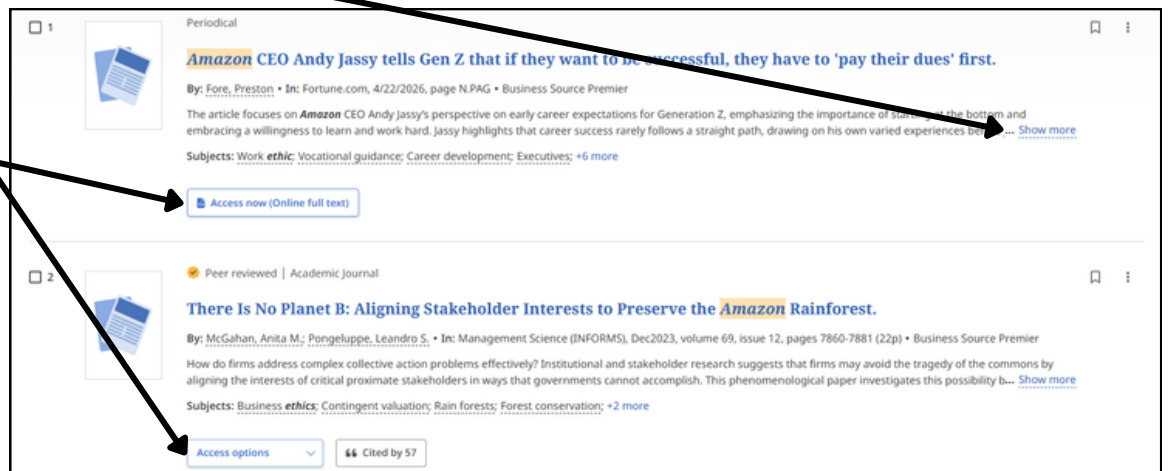
Using filters narrows your search results. For example, if you are looking for topics specific to an industry or place, you can limit by geography and industry to find only articles that address those subjects. .

Preview pane:

Click Show more to view a summary or brief citation of the article.

Company Profile Search

From the Advanced Search, go to the Publications tab.

Search your desired company by name or browse the list of companies alphabetically.

Click on the company name to find their profile.

Click on a date to read their MarketLine Profile report for that year.
